Announcing "ConGo Enjoy-Meant" Events

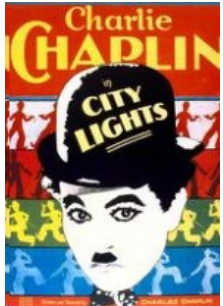
We are "ConGo" (Christians on the Go) and **meant to go and enjoy** good food and fun activities together!
